
Overview: CFIB surveys since mid-March

Previous surveys

- CFIB has surveyed members on the impacts of COVID-19 from the start of the pandemic (15 weekly surveys from mid March to early July, avg. n = 9,020)
- Moved towards biweekly surveys last summer (4 surveys from mid July to end of August, avg. n = 5,249), then monthly surveys in the fall (averaging over 5,000 responses)
- Current plan is to continue conducting monthly member surveys with key data on current business conditions through the *Your Voice* monthly survey)







How much of your usual staffing capacity for this time of year is your business currently using? (% response)





How much of your usual revenues for this time of year is your business currently making? (% response)










How long will it take your business to pay back its COVID-19 related debt? (% response)



How long will it take your business to pay back its COVID-19 related debt? Businesses that took on debt, by sector (% response)





How long do you think it will take your business to get back to its *usual* level of profitability? (% response)




















Government response to COVID-19, by province













